

Considerations for Girth Enhancement

1. Is It Right for Me?

This procedure typically takes 30–45 minutes and is performed on an outpatient basis. The results are not permanent, as hyaluronic acid is gradually broken down by the body. In some cases, results can be adjusted or reversed with an additional treatment. The procedure changes girth only, not length. It is not designed to address conditions such as erectile dysfunction (ED).




2. How Much Do Girth Injections Cost?

Costs vary depending on provider, location, and the amount of filler used. In 2025, pricing for hyaluronic acid injections has been reported to range from approximately \$4,000 to \$8,000 per procedure. Be sure to factor in travel costs associated with your preferred provider. Your closest provider may be a long car ride, plane, train, or bus ticket away.



3. What's Known About Safety and Outcomes?

Hyaluronic acid is a material already found in the body and has been used in other cosmetic procedures, such as facial fillers. Experiences with penile enhancement vary and reported discomfort levels differ between individuals.



4. Where is Your Nearest Provider?

Specialists who may offer this procedure include urologists and men's health or cosmetic providers. Availability may require travel, depending on where you live. When choosing a provider, it is important to learn about their experience, training, and the specific materials they use.

5. What's Healing Like?

After treatment, some individuals report bruising or swelling. Providers often recommend avoiding sexual activity and strenuous exercise for a period of time after the procedure to reduce the chance of filler shifting. Healing experiences differ, so it is best to follow your provider's specific aftercare instructions.
