1. What's Penuma?

Penuma is a silicone implant placed under the penile skin during a surgical procedure under anesthesia. It adds circumference and a fuller flaccid appearance but doesn't address length, erectile dysfunction, or sexual performance, and remains in place unless surgically removed.



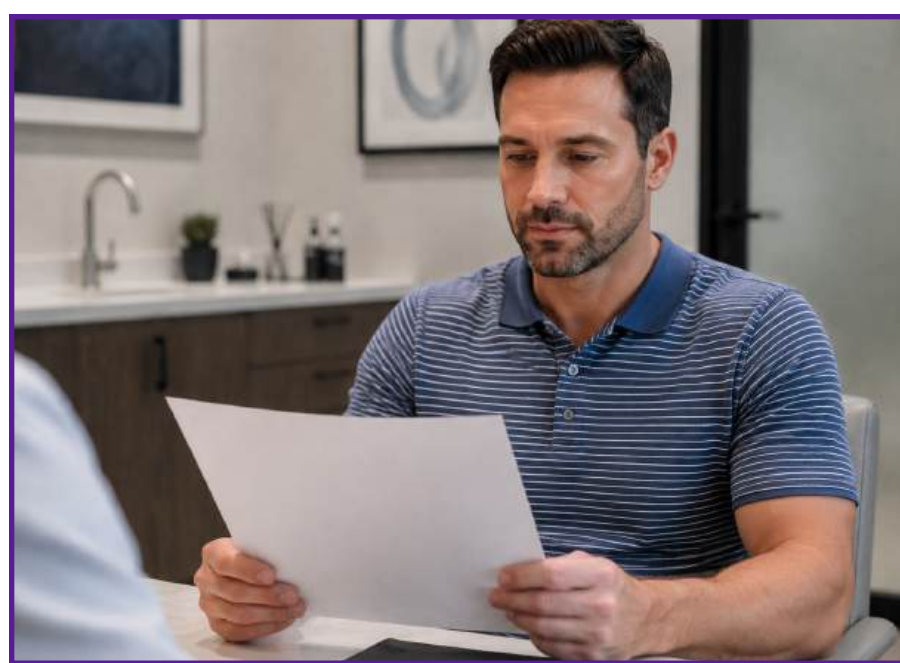
2. The Surgical Reality

Penuma requires anesthesia, incisions, and weeks of recovery before resuming normal activity or sexual activity. Addressing any asymmetry or unexpected outcome requires returning to the operating room, constraints that matter for men who value flexibility and minimal disruption.



3. Permanence Without Much Flexibility

The implant is designed to stay, removal requires another surgical procedure. Men who prefer building results gradually, evaluating at each stage, or reversing course entirely will find that a permanent implant doesn't support that kind of incremental approach.



4. What Non-Surgical Penile Enlargement Has to Offer

Hyaluronic acid girth enhancement takes about 45 minutes, requires no general anesthesia, and allows same-day return to normal activity. Results build gradually across sessions, and hyaluronidase can dissolve the filler without surgery if goals ever change.

Penuma suits men seeking a permanent surgical increase in penile girth, but for men whose goal is non-surgical enhancement, the surgical nature, permanent commitment, and recovery requirements stand directly at odds with what they're looking for.



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
